


Junior Scientists Participation Fellowship - Song Lin



Song Lin is an Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Howard Milstein Faculty Fellow at Cornell University. He obtained B.S. at Peking University in 2008 and Ph.D. at Harvard University in 2013, where he carried out graduate research with Prof. Eric Jacobsen. After postdoctoral training with Prof. Christopher Chang at UC Berkeley, he joined Cornell as a faculty member in 2016. The Lin Laboratory is interested in developing new catalytic strategies for organic synthesis with a particular emphasis on electrochemistry

and radical catalysis. Song has received several early career awards, including Sloan Fellowship, ONR Young Investigator Award, MIT Technology Review Innovators Under 35, Cottrell Scholar Award, and NSF CAREER Award.
