Angélique Ferry obtained her PhD, in 2013, on the synthesis of phostone and hydroxylamine-type glycomimetics (Prof. Crich, Dr. Guinchard). She received, in 2014, the Dina Surdin PhD Award of the French Chemical Society (SCF). Then, she joined Prof. Glorius team to work on heterogeneous metal-catalyzed reactions. In 2015, she became associate professor at the CY Cergy-Paris University. She develops metal-catalyzed functionalizations on glycosides. She received, in 2018, the "women and science" award of the CY Cergy-Paris University and, in 2020, the Emergence award

of the SCF and the GFG award of the French Group of Glycosciences.
