Paweł Dydio (1985) obtained his PhD (cum laude) in 2013 from U. Amsterdam (the Netherlands) with Joost Reek. In 2014-2016, he conducted a postdoctoral research at U.C. Berkeley, with John Hartwig, as a LBNL postdoctoral fellow and an NWO Rubicon postdoctoral scholar. In mid-2016, he moved back to Europe to be appointed an assistant professor and to direct a new laboratory at ISIS, U. Strasbourg (France). His research interests lie in the fields of homogeneous catalysis, bio-catalysis, supramolecular and organometallic chemistry, and

complex systems. He was awarded the IDEX Starting Grant 2016, the ERC Starting Grant 2018, and the Dream Chemistry Award Top 5 in 2020.
